The National Institute of Technology, Akashi College offers a one week course on Japanese Culture. Our course will include classes on Japanese traditional arts, visits to traditional buildings, workshops with Akashi students, and lectures on basic Japanese language and cultural concepts.

Akashi College is located in the Kansai area, near the cities of Kyoto, Nara, Osaka and Himeji.
